


THE AREA OF ELY CENTRE FOR OSTROBOTHNIA Employment Bulletin

February 2020

The unemployment increased in the area of ELY Centre for Ostrobothnia compared with the situation the year before



A total of 7 686 unemployed jobseekers were registered in the area of ELY Centre for Ostrobothnia at the end of February. This is 183 more than a year earlier. The number of unemployed jobseekers decreased by 30 from the previous month. The share of the unemployed jobseekers out of the labour force in the area of ELY Centre for Ostrobothnia is now the lowest (6,6 %) in the mainland Finland. In the whole country the respective share out of the labour force is 9.5 %.

Compared with January the share of the unemployed jobseekers out of the labour force decreased by 0,1 % in the area of ELY Centre for Ostrobothnia and in the whole country. The figures are from the Employment Service Statistics of the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment.

Trends:


- The unemployment in the area of ELY Centre for Ostrobothnia increased a little bit: the amount of the unemployed jobseekers was in February 183 more than the year before.
- The unemployment among young people decreased a little bit: the amount of unemployed under 25 years decreased by 16 persons (-1,6 %) compared with the year before.
- The amount of long-term unemployed increased with 119 persons compared with the situation the year before (+ 7,4 %).
- The number of new open vacancies in February was 330 less than the year before.
- The number of people in employment-promoting services is decreasing. In the end of February the amount of participants in services was in total 4 519 persons.






Unemployed jobseekers

${\bf UNEMPLOYED\ JOBSEEKERS,\ MONTH\ BY\ MONTH\ COMPARISON}$








Unemployed jobseekers by sub-regional unit






Unemployed jobseekers by gender and age-group









Unemployed jobseekers by levels of education and occupational group


UNEMPLOYED JOBSEEKERS BY LEVEL OF EDUCATION



Information about the website

On this website you will find the latest statistics from ELY Centre for Ostrobothnia's monthly Employment Bulletin. You can access a .pdf version of the current and previous months' Employment Bulletin by following the link on the right. The Employment Bulletin is based on the data from the MEAE's Employment Service Statistics. The Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment compiles statistics on the clients of the Employment and economic development offices (TE offices), including registered job-seekers, labour market policy services, and job vacancies reported to TE offices by employers. The data is collected from the customer service registry (URA) used by the TE offices. This means that the data used by MEAE Employment Service Statistics is completely registry-based. The statistical data covers all persons, services, and open vacancies in the aforementioned groups, as separately defined in the registry by the classifications and variables for the statistical period in question.

Owing to seasonal variations, the Employment Bulletin always includes a comparison with the corresponding month in the previous year. The descriptors used in the Bulletin are also available in a table format. The Employment Bulletins are published at the end of the subsequent calendar month. The official date of publication is announced in advance.
